



FAQs about the Victorian Cancer Agency Funding

Will funding opportunities be available from the Agency every year?

We hope to provide annual or if appropriate, biannual funding opportunities from 2008 onwards.

If I have received previous funding from the Agency, can I apply again?

Yes.

If I already have some funding for a project, can I submit a proposal for additional support?

Yes, as long as it fits with grant criteria. However, there must be no duplication in the funding requests, e.g., if a salary is already supported from another source, you cannot apply to the Agency for that salary.

Can funding be used to extend an existing project?

Yes, as long as the proposal fits with grant criteria and indicates a discrete research objective with no duplication of funding from other sources.

Will there be any post evaluation feedback to the applicant?

Applicants may be contacted during the decision-making process if additional information is required. Both successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified of final funding decisions.

Who will own IP rights to research findings?

The administering organisation will own any IP developed in Agency funded research. This organisation will be expected to commercialise findings in a manner that ensures fair and reasonable access for the Victorian public.
